ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


Pursuant to an order entered on August 30, 2006, the opening brief and appendix in this appeal were due to be filed by January 23, 2007. Appellant failed to file the opening brief by that date. However, on January 31, 2007, appellant's counsel advised the clerk of this court by telephone that the parties settled this matter and that a stipulation to dismiss this appeal would be filed within a week.

On April 30, 2007, this court entered an order noting that as of that date, appellant had failed to file either the opening brief and appendix or a stipulation to dismiss this appeal. Our April 30, 2007, order directed appellant to file and serve the opening brief and appendix by May 10, 2007. Alternatively, within the same time period, the parties could file a stipulation to dismiss this appeal. Our order cautioned that failure to comply timely with the order might result in the dismissal of this appeal as abandoned.


To date, appellant still has not filed the opening brief and appendix, nor have the parties filed a stipulation to dismiss the appeal. Indeed, appellant has not filed any documents or otherwise communicated

with this court since he called the clerk on January 31, 2007. In light of the foregoing, it appears appellant has abandoned this appeal. Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal.
