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ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This court previously disapproved the parties' stipulation to dismiss this appeal because the appeal was stayed pursuant to federal bankruptcy law. Prior to the stay being imposed, this court had allowed appellant's counsel of record to withdraw and twice directed appellant to retain new counsel and to cause new counsel to file a notice of appearance with this court.
