ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a post-divorce decree order entered by the district court. Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Court Division, Clark County; Terrance P. Marren, Judge.

Appellant's notice of appeal was filed in this court on January 9, 2007. When the notice of appeal was filed, appellant was mailed a civil proper person appeal statement and other documents, as part of the pilot program for proper person civil appeals.¹ As noted in the instructions accompanying the documents mailed to appellant, appellant was required to file her appeal statement within forty days from the date her appeal was filed in this court.² The instructions further explained that if






appellant failed to file the appeal statement by that date, this court would dismiss the appeal.³

Appellant's appeal statement was due on February 20, 2007. To date, appellant has not filed an appeal statement or otherwise responded to this court's directive. Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal.
