ORDER OF REMAND

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a guilty plea, of one count of obtaining and/or using the personal identification information of another. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Noel E. Manoukian, Judge. The district court sentenced appellant Randy William Hubbard to a prison term of 12 to 36 months, with no credit for time served.

Hubbard's sole contention on appeal is that the district court erred by refusing to grant him credit for 89 days of presentence confinement. The State concedes that the district court's denial of credit for time served appears to be incorrect. We conclude that this matter should be remanded for a determination as to what credit should be granted.

Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED IN PART AND VACATED IN PART AND REMAND this matter to the district court for proceedings consistent with this order.
