ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of prohibition and/or mandamus. Petitioner claims that he has been placed in administrative segregation because of a threat made by another inmate against him—a threat for which petitioner claims there is no proof. It appears that petitioner is seeking an order directing the Warden at the Southern Desert Correctional Center to place him back into the general population or transfer him to another institution. We have considered the documents submitted in this matter, and we conclude that this court's intervention in


