
ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioners assert that they have been denied timely parole hearings and seek an order: (1) compelling the Nevada Board of Parole Commissioners to provide written notice to parole applicants when a parole hearing is terminated or suspended and to provide written notice of the rescheduled dates; and (2) permitting Governor Jim Gibbons or the Director of Prisons, Howard Skolnik, to immediately release inmates who have missed timely parole hearings. We have considered the documents submitted to this court, and we conclude that this court's intervention in this matter is not warranted at this time.¹ Petitioners should raise their claims regarding


