



ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner asserts that he has not been provided with a timely parole hearing. Petitioner seeks an order directing the Parole Board to immediately conduct a hearing, or alternatively, to grant him release on parole. We have reviewed the documents submitted before this court, and we conclude that this court's intervention in this matter is not warranted at this time.¹ Petitioner should raise his claim regarding the parole hearing in a petition for a writ of mandamus filed in his criminal case in
