ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of prohibition. Petitioner seeks an order arresting the proceedings of the Parole Board. Petitioner asserts that the deadly weapon enhancement was improperly added to his voluntary manslaughter conviction; thus, the Parole Board has no authority to require him to serve a minimum term for parole eligibility on the deadly weapon enhancement sentence. We have considered the documents submitted to this court, and we conclude that extraordinary relief is not warranted.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
