ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of prohibition. Petitioner challenges the failure of the district court to specify a restitution amount in the original judgment of conviction and the district court's order that he pay restitution in an amount to be determined at a later date. We have considered the documents submitted in this matter, and we conclude that this court's intervention in this matter is not warranted at this time.<sup>1</sup> Appellant should litigate this issue in the district court in the first instance. Notably, petitioner has filed a petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition in the district court raising the same


