ORDER DISMISSING PETITION AS TO CERTAIN RESPONDENT  
ATTORNEYS AND GRANTING PETITION AS TO OTHERS

On September 15, 2008, the Board of Continuing Legal Education (the Board) filed a petition with this court regarding the status of certain members of the State Bar of Nevada (respondent attorneys) who have failed to comply with various Supreme Court Rules governing continuing legal education. See SCR 205-215. Specifically, the Board petitioned this court to order those respondent attorneys who are presently active to show cause why their membership status should not be changed to CLE suspended and, from the date of such change of status, be barred from practicing law in the State of Nevada until reinstated under SCR 212(6) and 213. Further, as to those respondent attorneys who are already inactive, disabled or suspended, to show cause why their rights of reinstatement to active status should not be conditioned upon full compliance with SCR 213, in addition to any conditions of reinstatement already imposed upon them.

On October 30, 2008, this court entered an order dismissing the Board's petition as to certain respondent attorneys who had come into compliance with SCR 205 through 215 after the filing of the petition and as to whom the Board had filed a "Consent to Dismissal." We directed the remaining attorneys to show cause why this court should not grant the Board's petition to change their status from active to CLE suspended and to condition their right to be reinstated upon full compliance with SCR 212(6) and 213.

On November 19 and 26, 2008, and December 2, 2008, the Board filed documents entitled "Consent to Dismissal," informing this court that the following attorneys have satisfied the requirements set forth in SCR 205 through 215 after the filing of the court's show cause order: James G. Allen, Steven M. Altig, Joseph D. Bunin, Courtney L. Bunt, Jeffrey D. Conway, Jorge G. Corral, Gregory V. Cortese, Rhial N. Devine, Ronald E. Gillette, Kent B. Hanson, William J. Heck, George W. Johnson, Robert J. Kern, James W. King, Francis Kocka, Kenneth W. Long, Bradley S. Mainor, Wendy E. Miller, James R. Rosenberger, Ulrich W. Smith, Robert K. Sparks, and Amy W. Stengel. Accordingly, we grant the Board's requests and we dismiss the Board's petition with prejudice as to the above-named respondent attorneys.

The remaining active attorneys have failed to respond to our show cause order entered October 30, 2008. Accordingly, we grant the Board's petition as to these attorneys. The status of the following active respondent attorneys shall be changed to *CLE suspended*, and their rights of reinstatement shall be conditioned upon full compliance with SCR 212(6) and 213:
