

ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner seeks immediate release from confinement because the Department of Corrections has improperly calculated his credit for time served. We have considered the documents submitted in this matter, and we conclude that this court's intervention in this matter is not warranted.¹ A challenge to the computation of time served must be raised in a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed in the district court in the first instance.² Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
