ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner claims that his due process rights were violated at a prison disciplinary hearing. Petitioner seeks an order changing his custody and monetary damages for every day he is incarcerated beyond his expiration date. We have considered the documents submitted in this matter, and we conclude that no relief is warranted at this time.¹ Petitioner may challenge the forfeiture of statutory good time credits in a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed in the district court in the first instance.² Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
