ORDER

These are appeals from separate judgments of conviction filed in separate district court cases.

On October 8, 1999, counsel for appellant filed a motion to dismiss Docket Number 34797. This appeal relates to district court case number CR97-1778, from Department 8 of the Second Judicial District Court. The judgment of conviction was appealed and decided by this court in Jennings v. State, Docket No. 33037 (Order Dismissing Appeal, December 8, 1998). Counsel informs this court that the instant notice of appeal in Docket Number 34797 was inadvertently filed from the same district case number that had already been appealed. It is clear, however, from the notice of appeal that appellant intended to
