




ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner claims he was denied a timely parole hearing and denied the proper classification. Petitioner seeks an order of release, alteration of his release dates or credits. Petitioner further seeks monetary damages and an order directing the Department of Corrections not to take money from his account. We have reviewed the documents submitted in this matter, and without deciding upon the merits of any claims, we decline to exercise original jurisdiction in this matter. NRS 34.160; NRS 34.170. Petitioner should file a petition for a writ of mandamus in the district court in the first instance. Accordingly, we
