ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR
WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a district court order permitting petitioner's counsel in the underlying district court action to withdraw. Having reviewed the petition and its exhibits, we are not persuaded that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted, as it does not appear that the district court manifestly abused its discretion in permitting counsel's withdrawal. NRAP 21(b)(1); Smith v. District Court, 107 Nev. 674, 818 P.2d 849 (1991); Koza v. District Court, 99 Nev. 535, 665 P.2d 244 (1983). Accordingly, we
