

ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus seeks to compel this court to allow petitioners to intervene in an appeal pending in this court, Building & Construction Trades v. Carson City School Dist., Docket No. 57730. Having reviewed the petition and appendix, we are not persuaded that writ relief is warranted, as petitioners have a plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law, barring extraordinary relief, in the form of a motion in that appeal. NRS 34.170; NRAP 21(b)(1); Smith v. District Court, 107 Nev. 674, 818 P.2d 849 (1991). Accordingly, we
