This is a review of a decision of a hearing panel in a bar disciplinary matter.

On May 17, 2012, a hearing panel of the Northern Nevada Disciplinary Board entered findings of fact, conclusions of law and a decision in this matter, recommending the suspension of attorney Jeffery A. Briggs. The recommendation of the panel was based in part on Briggs' failure to participate in the hearing. This matter was docketed in this court, pursuant to SCR 105(3), and subsequently, counsel for Briggs filed a motion to remand this matter back to the State Bar for a full hearing. The motion is unopposed.

Cause appearing, the motion is granted, and this matter is remanded back to the Northern Nevada Disciplinary Board for a full hearing.

It is so ORDERED.¹
