ORDER OF REVERSAL AND REMAND

This is an appeal from an order, certified as final under NRCP 54(b), granting a motion to dismiss in a quiet title action. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Valorie J. Vega, Judge.

The district court granted Bank of America's motion to dismiss, finding that Drysdale Circle Trust had failed to state a viable claim for relief because NRS 116.3116(2)'s superpriority provision "generally affords first mortgage lien holders priority over assessment liens" and "requires an HOA to institute a judicial action in order to trigger and enforce any super priority lien." This court's recent disposition in SFR Investments Pool 1, LLC v. U.S. Bank, N.A., 130 Nev. ____, 334 P.3d 408 (2014), decides that a common-interest community association's NRS 116.3116(2) superpriority lien has true priority over a first security interest, and the association may nonjudicially foreclose on that lien. The district court's decision thus was based on an erroneous interpretation of

the controlling law and did not reach the other issues colorably asserted. Accordingly, we

REVERSE the order granting the motion to dismiss AND REMAND for proceedings consistent with this order.
