## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal challenging district court rulings entered as part of an appeal from the district court from a decision of the justice court. District courts, however, have final appellate jurisdiction over cases arising in the justice courts. Nev. Const. art. 6, § 6; see also Waugh v. Casazza, 85 Nev. 520, 521, 458 P.2d 359, 360 (1969) (noting that "[t]he district court has final appellate jurisdiction in cases arising in the justice's court").
