ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from a district court minute order refusing to vacate a restraining order and failing to grant contact between appellant and his minor children. Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Court Division, Clark County; Robert Teuton, Judge.

Our review of the documents on file with this court reveals a number of jurisdictional defects. The right to appeal is statutory; where no statute or court rule authorizes an appeal, no right to appeal exists. Taylor Constr. Co. v. Hilton Hotels, 100 Nev. 207, 678 P.2d 1152 (1984); Kokkos v. Tsalikis, 94 Nev. 24, 53 P.2d 756 (1975). Specifically, no statute or court rule permits an appeal from an order refusing to vacate a restraining order or from failing to grant contact between a parent and his children. See also In re Temporary Custody of Five Minors, 105 Nev. 441, 777 P.2d 901 (1989) (an order determining temporary custody of minors is not appealable). Finally, the district court docket entries indicate that the district court's decision is not yet final, but instead is scheduled for further review. An appealable final judgment is (1) any written order or judgment



of the district court (2) that has been entered by the clerk and (3) that finally resolves all claims and issues against all parties to the action and leaves nothing for the district court's future consideration except for post-judgment issues such as attorney fees and costs. *Lee v. GNLV*, 116 Nev. 424, 996 P.2d 416 (2000). Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction over this appeal and we order the appeal dismissed.

It is so ORDERED.
