## ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS AND/OR PROHIBITION

This original writ petition seeks mandamus and/or prohibition relief with regard to various actions purportedly taken or not taken by the respondent district court judges.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires as a duty resulting from an office, trust, or station or to control a manifest abuse of discretion. See NRS 34.160; Round Hill Gen. Improvement Dist. v. Newman, 97 Nev. 601, 603-04, 637 P.2d 534, 536 (1981). We may issue a writ of prohibition to arrest the proceedings of a district court exercising its judicial functions when such proceedings are in excess of the jurisdiction of the district court. See NRS 34.320. Neither mandamus nor prohibition will issue when the petitioner has a plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law. NRS 34.170; NRS 34.330. Both mandamus and prohibition are extraordinary remedies, and

whether a petition for extraordinary relief will be considered is solely within our discretion. See Cote H. v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 124 Nev. 36, 39, 175 P.3d 906, 908 (2008). It is petitioner's burden to demonstrate that our extraordinary intervention is warranted. Pan v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004). Having considered the petition and supporting documentation, we conclude that our intervention by way of extraordinary relief is not warranted, and we therefore deny the petition. See Smith v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 107 Nev. 674, 677, 818 P.2d 849, 851 (1991); see also NRAP 21(b)(1).

It is so ORDERED.<sup>1</sup>
