

ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a petition for a writ of mandamus. Petitioner Andres Delatorre seeks an order directing the dismissal of charges against him. He asserts the Washoe County District Attorney's Office has violated the Interstate Agreement on Detainers and has violated his due process right to a speedy trial. We have reviewed the documents submitted in this matter, and without deciding upon the merits of any claims raised therein, we decline to exercise original jurisdiction in this matter. See NRS 34.160; NRS 34.170. Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.¹

¹We note Delatorre may seek dismissal of the charges against him by filing an appropriate motion or petition in the district court. Delatorre appears to assert he previously filed a petition for a writ of mandamus seeking dismissal of the charges against him. However, because he indicates he filed the petition with the "Superior Court of Nevada, County of Washoe" and no such court exists in Nevada, it is unclear whether his petition was actually received by the appropriate court. We further note it appears Delatorre is represented by Washoe County public defenders Sean B. Sullivan and Christopher Frey in his district court case. Delatorre should proceed by and through his counsel of record.
