## ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Kamren Wilson appeals from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a guilty plea, of coercion, sexually motivated. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Elissa F. Cadish, Judge.

Wilson argues the district court abused its discretion when it sentenced him without first conducting a proportionality review, in violation of Houk v. State, 103 Nev. 659, 747 P.2d 1376 (1987). The district court has wide discretion in its sentencing decision, and Houk does not require any formal proportionality review by the sentencing court. See id. Houk discusses the matter only in terms of the appellate court's proportionality review and in the context of analyzing a claim that a sentence is cruel and unusual in violation of the Eighth Amendment. See id. Wilson does not argue his sentence is unconstitutionally cruel and unusual. Nor does he argue the district court considered "information or accusations founded on facts supported only by impalpable or highly suspect evidence." Silks v. State, 92 Nev. 91, 94, 545 P.2d 1159, 1161 (1976). We note Wilson's sentence is within the statutory guidelines, see NRS 207.190(2)(a), and is not disproportionate to the crime he committed. We

therefore conclude the district court did not abuse its discretion in sentencing Wilson.

To the extent Wilson seeks to withdraw his guilty plea, that claim is not properly before this court. See Rimer v. State, 131 Nev. \_\_\_, \_\_\_ n.3, 351 P.3d 697, 713 n.3 (2015) (this court need not consider arguments not raised in the district court); Harris v. State, 130 Nev. \_\_\_, \_\_\_, 329 P.3d 619, 628 (2014) (a post-sentencing motion to withdraw a guilty plea must be raised in a postconviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus). Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.
