ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from an order revoking appellant's probation. Our review of this appeal indicates that the district court entered the order revoking appellant's probation on June 29, 1995. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until September 6, 2000, well after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court. See *Lozada v. State*, 110 Nev. 349, 871 P.2d 944 (1994). Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal dismissed.
