

ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is an original petition for a writ of certiorari in which petitioner Ashley Stacey Torres seeks to have this court reverse her justice court conviction of battery constituting domestic violence. Torres argues her use of force was justifiable and the district court erred by denying her appeal from the justice court's decision to find her guilty. We have considered the petition and decline to exercise our original jurisdiction because Torres has not demonstrated "the district court has improperly refused to exercise its jurisdiction, has exceeded its jurisdiction, or has exercised its discretion in an arbitrary or capricious manner." *State v.*

Eighth Judicial Dist. Court (Hedlund), 116 Nev. 127, 134, 994 P.2d 692, 696
(2000). Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
