ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Dennis J. Kopp appeals from a district court order dismissing a postconviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed on May 10, 2018.¹ First Judicial District Court, Carson City; James E. Wilson, Judge.


The record reveals Kopp filed a petition in which he claimed the Nevada Department of Corrections was not applying his statutory credits to his minimum sentence as required by NRS 209.4465(7)(b). The district court ordered Kopp to file a supplemental petition that alleged when his crime was committed. Kopp filed a supplemental petition but it did not allege when his crime was committed. The district court subsequently ordered the petition dismissed.


Based on this record, we conclude Kopp failed to demonstrate he was entitled to relief and the district court did not err by dismissing his petition. *See Hargrove v. State*, 100 Nev. 498, 502-03, 686 P.2d 222, 225

(1984) (petitioner has the burden of pleading specific facts that show he is entitled to relief). Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
