ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

James Eugene Hermanson appeals from an order of the district court denying a petition for a writ of mandamus.¹ Third Judicial District Court, Lyon County; Leon Aberasturi, Judge.

Hermanson petitioned the district court to issue a writ of mandamus ordering itself to produce evidence that it denied Hermanson's May 2017 motion to withdraw his guilty plea. The district court denied Hermanson's petition but also attached the order disposing of the motion to withdraw his guilty plea. Because the district court's order provided Hermanson the relief he sought in his petition, Hermanson was not an
