ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Juan J. Tarelo appeals from an order of the district court denying a postconviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Linda Marie Bell, Judge.

In his May 4, 2016, petition, Tarelo claimed the Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) improperly declined to apply his statutory credits toward his minimum term. The district court concluded Tarelo was not entitled to relief because Tarelo is currently serving a prison term for a category B felony, committed in 2011, and for those reasons, the NDOC may only apply Tarelo's statutory credits toward his maximum term pursuant to NRS 209.4465(8)(d).² Given these
