ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Mark Sims appeals from an amended judgment of conviction filed on April 13, 2022. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Jerry A. Wiese, Chief Judge.

Sims claims the district court erred by fully revoking his probation. However, the judgment of conviction Sims appeals from did not fully revoke his probation. Because Sims' claim on appeal does not arise from any amendment reflected in the April 13, 2022, amended judgment of conviction, his claim is not properly raised in this appeal. See Jackson v. State, 133 Nev. 880, 882, 410 P.3d 1004, 1006 (Ct. App. 2017). Therefore, we

ORDER the amended judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.1
