
ORDER APPROVING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

NRCP 1 and EDCR 1.10 state that procedure in district courts shall be administered to secure efficient, speedy, and inexpensive determination of every action. Pursuant to EDCR 2.23 (c) and 5.501 (b), this Court can consider a motion and issue a decision on the papers at any time with or without oral argument.

Eighth Judicial District Court Administrative Order 20-17 provides: "The Court may deny a motion at any time. The Court may grant all or any part of motion after an opposition has been filed or 21 days after service of the motion if no opposition has been filed."

This Court has read and considered the current underlying pleadings in this matter. On May 4, 2022, Respondent filed Respondent's Rule 60(c) Motion to Set

1
2 Aside Default and Default Judgment, and Writ Pursuant Thereto.

3 This Court finds that Motion to Set Aside Default has been previously addressed
4 and denied in prior hearings. On June 30, 2020, this Court made extensive findings as
5 to Respondent's motions including the Respondent's Motion to Set Aside the Default
6 and denied the motion based on prior District Court and Supreme Court orders on this
7 very issue.

8
9 On June 29, 2021, the Hon. Judge Ames issued a Judicial Order, denying
10 Respondent's pending motions with the findings that "Respondent's various
11 motion/demand/notices there is a common nucleus that Respondent's dispute over
12 paternity, jurisdiction and enforcement of the child support order. The Hon. Judge
13 Ames quotes the Nevada Supreme Court findings regarding Respondent's "serial filings"
14 and "Respondent's filings do not state any facts or arguments that constitute adequate
15 cause to reconsider the order from the prior hearings". Hon. Ames made the same
16 findings as to the motions in the instant case.

17
18 Despite the June 29, 2021 court order, Respondent, on two more occasions, filed
19 "Motion(s) to Set Aside Default Judgments" that were also denied by this Court. See
20 Report and Recommendations filed on September 13, 2021 and December 8, 2021.


21 Additionally, Hon. Ames found Respondent to be a vexatious litigant in case R-
22 17-196685-R. The Judge ordered that "Respondent cannot file any motions concerning
23 jurisdiction or paternity. Any other motions must be submitted to the court prior to filing.
24 Only after review by the court and permission of the court will any future motion be
25 allowed in this case." Respondent has not complied with the Judicial Order filed on

3 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that Respondent's Motion to
4 Set Aside Default Judgment is denied.

5 IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED that the hearing in this matter, currently set
6 for July 12, 2022 at 9:45 a.m., be VACATED.
