ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Talib Lamar Spears appeals from a judgment of conviction, entered pursuant to a guilty plea, of sex trafficking of an adult and battery with a deadly weapon. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Kathleen M. Drakulich, Judge.

Spears argues the district court abused its discretion by denying his pretrial petition for a writ of habeas corpus, which had challenged the sufficiency of the evidence presented during the grand jury proceedings. Errors that arise before entry of a guilty plea are ordinarily waived by entry of the guilty plea, *see Webb v. State*, 91 Nev. 469, 470, 538 P.2d 164, 165 (1975), and Spears does not argue that he preserved this

alleged error as part of his guilty plea, *see* NRS 174.035(3). Therefore, we conclude Spears' claim is waived. Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.¹
