



ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from a post-judgment district court order granting a motion to change venue. Eleventh Judicial District Court, Pershing County; Jim C. Shirley, Judge.

Initial review of the docketing statement and documents before this court reveals a jurisdictional defect. This court “may only consider appeals authorized by statute or court rule.” *Brown v. MHC Stagecoach, LLC*, 129 Nev. 343, 345, 301 P.3d 850, 851 (2013). No statute or court rule authorizes an appeal from a post-judgment order granting a motion to change venue. Accordingly, this court lacks jurisdiction and

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.<sup>1</sup>
