ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from a district court "Order Holding in Abeyance all Motions Filed Post-November 28, 2022, and Staying Applicability of 4JDCR 10(6) Until Further Order" and from a district court "Order in Response to Emergency Ex Parte Request for Direction." Fourth Judicial District Court, Elko County; Robert E. Estes, Judge.
