*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*

This is a pro se appeal. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Erika D. Ballou, Judge.

Review of the notice of appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Appellant's notice states he is appealing from the "opinion of Jennifer L.G. Schwartz entered January 19, 2024."
