ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This is a pro se appeal from a judgment of conviction. Fifth Judicial District Court, Nye County; Robert W. Lane, Judge.

On April 18, 2025, this court entered an order directing appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Appellate counsel filed a response on April 28, 2025, conceding that the notice of appeal was untimely filed. Accordingly, this court lacks jurisdiction to consider this appeal, *see Lozada v. State*, 110 Nev. 349, 352, 871 P.2d 944, 946 (1994) “[A]n untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court.”), and therefore we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED¹.
