
*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*

Juan Pablo Gomez Zamora appeals from a district court order denying a “motion to vacate judgment of conviction” filed on July 16, 2024. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Jessica K. Peterson, Judge.

Our review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. The right to appeal is statutory; where no statute or court rule provides for an appeal, no right to appeal exists. *Castillo v. State*, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990). No statute or court rule permits an appeal from an

order denying a motion to vacate judgment of conviction.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
