

ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from a district court order denying a pre-trial petition for writ of habeas corpus. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Scott N. Freeman, Judge.

This court's review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, no appeal lies from an order denying a pretrial petition for a writ of habeas corpus. *Gary v. Sheriff*, 96 Nev. 78, 605 P.2d 212 (1980) (order denying pretrial habeas relief is an intermediate order that may be challenged in a timely appeal from the judgment of conviction); *Sheriff v. Gillock*, 112 Nev. 213, 912 P.2d 274 (1996) (only the State may appeal from a district court order granting in part and denying in part a pretrial petition for a writ of habeas corpus). Accordingly, this court lacks jurisdiction and ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
