ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a final judgment in a forfeiture case. On July 2, 2002, we denied respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal, and directed appellant to pay the filing fee required by NRS 2.250(1)(a) within fifteen days. Alternatively, if appellant could not afford the filing fee, we granted him fifteen days within which to file an application for in forma pauperis status with the district court, and directed him to submit a copy of any such application to this court within thirty days from the date of the order. Over three months have passed, and appellant has failed to respond to our July 2 order in any way. We conclude that appellant has abandoned this appeal, and accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
