

ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS


This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus challenging a district court order that expunged petitioner's notice of lis pendens. We have considered the petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's

intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted.¹ Accordingly, we deny the petition.² The motion for a stay is denied as moot.
