

## ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This is a petition for reinstatement to the practice of law by suspended attorney Arnold Weinstock. Weinstock was suspended on October 23, 2000, for twelve months, based on several ethical violations. Weinstock filed a petition for reinstatement with the state bar on July 16, 2002. A hearing was held before a Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board panel, which issued its findings of fact, decision and recommendation. The record was docketed with this court on November 1, 2002.

The panel concluded that Weinstock met his burden under SCR 116(3), to establish by clear and convincing evidence that he has the requisite moral qualifications, competency and learning in the law, and that his reinstatement will not be detrimental to the integrity of the bar, the administration of justice or the public interest. The panel issued a recommendation that the petition be granted, on certain conditions. The conditions require Weinstock to: (1) participate in a mentor program for one year following his reinstatement, with a mentor approved by the state bar, who must be an attorney other than Weinstock's counsel, Orin Grossman, or Weinstock's previous mentor, Robert Giunta; (2) take and pass the Multi-State Professional Responsibility Examination within six months after his reinstatement; and (3) refrain from engaging in solo

practice for the first year following his reinstatement. Weinstock stipulated to these conditions.

Having reviewed the record, we conclude that clear and convincing evidence supports the panel's findings, and that its recommendation should be approved. Accordingly, Arnold Weinstock is hereby reinstated to the practice of law, subject to the conditions set forth above.

It is so ORDERED.
