

ORDER OF REPRIMAND



Pursuant to SCR 113 and in exchange for a stated form of discipline, attorney David Lee Phillips tendered a conditional plea of guilty to a charge of professional misconduct alleged in a formal disciplinary complaint. Phillips agreed to receive a public reprimand. The plea was accepted by a hearing panel of the Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board, which thereafter forwarded its findings and recommendations to this court for final approval. See SCR 113(1).

Cause appearing, we approve the stated form of discipline set forth in the board's findings and recommendations. We order that a public reprimand issue against attorney Phillips. Phillips shall also be assessed the costs of the disciplinary proceedings.



ORDER



Pursuant to our order of reprimand in this disciplinary proceeding, we authorize the publication, in accordance with SCR 121, of the following letter of public reprimand.

To: David Lee Phillips, Attorney at Law:

In October of 1988, you were hired by a client to prosecute claims arising from an automobile accident. You failed to maintain adequate communication with your client and you failed to diligently pursue the action before you were forced to withdraw from the case in January of 1992. Your conduct is in violation of SCR 153 (diligence) and 154 (communication) and warrants disciplinary action. Accordingly, you are publicly reprimanded.
